- Stores legal, court, school, criminal (when applicable), and personal records in a virtual, password-protected vault

## **File MD™** Protects Foster Children

Professionals use the **File MD** electronic health records service to safely store medical history of foster children. When a child moves to another home or facility, their health information moves with them. **File MD** ensures:

- Safe storage of all foster child electronic health records (EHRs) in one location
- Approved physicians, in any location, will have instant access to the child's password-protected medical files for instant, accurate treatment
- Foster care parents enjoy a hassle-free method of retrieving health data about the children in their care
- Automated administration reports for members to ensure compliance with medical standards and to track statistics such as immunization renewals



## **Call RN™** Provides Foster Child Caretakers with Easy Document Transfers

**Call RN** Centers are staffed with experienced, registered nurses licensed to practice in the U.S. They provide foster child caretakers, often burdened with excessive case loads and manpower shortages, with the added support they need to manage the files for each child. The nurses:

- **Monitor a 24/7/365 hotline to assist foster care professionals**
- **Update foster child electronic health records (EHR)**
- **Coordinate medical and non-medical electronic data storage transfers**



## **rCard** Mobilizes Foster Child Records

The American Medical Association revealed that every year 100 million Americans, one-third of whom are unable to communicate, make a trip to the emergency room. Further, roughly 35% of these unplanned visits are compromised because medical record information is not available or is lost. Foster children are no exception and there is an added difficulty in accessing their personal emergency medical data because they usually reside at multiple locations. Americare offers an electronic medical business card - the **rCard** - that stores and displays the child's emergency medical information. The **rCard**:

- **Displays the personal medical data needed to accurately treat a foster child regardless of where he or she is living**
- **Provides emergency workers and foster parents with a convenient method to mobilize critical data for those in their care**
